JANAMASHTMI

Sweeter than honey, tastier than curd, pleasanter indeed than any happiness and joy is the company, is the power of the name of Krishna. The birthday of Lord Krishna is celebrated with great devotion and enthusiasm, on this Janmashtami day, in India. Krishna Janmashtami, also known as Krishnashtami, is observed on the Ashtami tithi, the eighth day of the dark half or Krishna Paksha of the month of Shraavana. Lord Krishna is known world wide and celebrated as an avatar of God Vishnu.

On Monday, 18TH of August 2022, the students of Edify School celebrated Janmashtami. The students from IKS to 5th came traditionally dressed as Radha and Krishna. A splendidly colorful program was organized by the children and staff of the school; where students presented songs, dance performances and a short role play. An awareness on Janmashtami, the mythological stories on Krishna, Radha, Kansh – through plays and narrations; were presented to the children. The event is based on the legend of the Krishna stealing butter and other milk products as a baby (he is also called Makhan chor). The little Krishna scrambling upon his friends who form a human pyramid to reach the Dahi (butter & curd) Pot. This holy occasion brings people together, thus signifying unity and faith.
